



- The abstract should contain specific objectives, methodology and results with 4-5 keywords not exceeding 200 words.
- 4. Full length research paper should be written in APA format and should not exceed 4000 words
- 5. The text should be typed in MS Word with 1.5 space, Times New Roman font size 12.
- Selected papers will be published in an edited volume with ISBN number. Publication charges will be borne by the participants.

How to reach Banasthali

- Train Route: Banasthali-Newai Railway Station is on the Jaipur-Sawai Madhopur-Mumbai broad gauge line of the western Railway. It is situated between Jaipur and Sawai Madhopur, equidistant (66Kms) from both.
- Road Route: Approx. 72 Kms from Jaipur, with regular plying of RSRTC buses.
- Air Route: Jaipur International Airport is 59 Kms from Banasthali Vidyapith.
